Secure the Shed

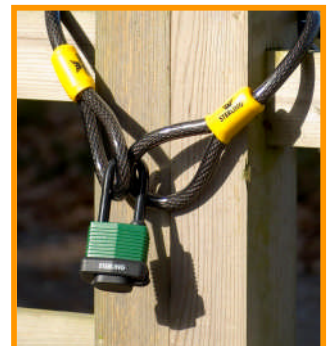
